Homecoming Court Rules Participation in Homecoming Court is a PRIVILEGE NOT a right.

The Student Government Association's Homecoming Court is a representation of the most involved and spirited student role models at WMHS. Selected students are voted on by their peers to represent their class during the designated day and time.

In order to be considered for the Homecoming Court, participants must currently have a minimum 2.5 GPA. All applicants must not have any major referrals or excessive tardies from the second semester of the previous school year through the application deadline. If a candidate has skipped any of their classes at any point during the time frame it is an automatic disgualification. It is also required that each applicant have a campus sponsor, the approval signature of an Administrator and a parent/guardian signature in order to participate.

With this application, all SGA Homecoming Court Candidates need to complete ALL of the following to be eligible:

- GPA of 2.5 on the 4.0 scale or Higher. ATTACH TRANSCRIPT
- No referrals and no excessive tardies.
- Campus Sponsor (school faculty member)
- Administrator approval
- Parent signature
- Application for Homecoming Court
- 3 Teacher Recommendations
- Biography 0
- Submit a 50-name petition of students within your grade level class. For examples a 12th Grade Candidate must have 50 seniors sign his/her petition
- Complete Homecoming Court Rules Acknowledgement Form

ALL Applicants must be available for **ALL** designated Homecoming activities such as the ones listed below and must agree to the following terms to be eligible:

- King/Queen candidates must be present for parade
- King/Queen candidates must be present at practice the day before Homecoming; time TBA.
- King/Queen candidates must be present at the rehearsal for the Pep Rally
- King/Queen candidates must be present at the Homecoming Pep-Rally
- King/Queen candidates must be at the for the Homecoming game by 6:30 pm (Only candidate and escort are allowed. **Escort must have a ticket for the game**.)
- King/Queen candidates must be present at the Homecoming Dance
- \circ Any tie in the votes will be awarded to the applicant with the highest GPA and/or class rank

If Elected You will be a representative of West Mecklenburg High School and must conduct yourself in a mature and appropriate way at all times. You may be required to participate in community events (parades, etc.) and you must wear your crown and appropriate attire for such events.

HOMECOMING COURT RULES ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

The Homecoming Court will consist of 24 WMHS students Max.
Seniors (King/Queen) : 6 King / Queen candidates (12 total)
Juniors (Prince/Princess) : 2 Prince / Princess candidates (4 total)
Sophomores (Duke/Duchess) : 2 Prince / Princess candidates (4 total)
Freshman (Count/Countess): 2 Prince / Princess candidates (4 Total)

- 1. All senior candidates must be officially classified as seniors as of the first day of school in the current school year; juniors and sophomores must be officially classified as well.
- 2. All candidates must return the ATTACHED Homecoming Court Rules and Acknowledgement Form to the Senior Council Advisors by their designated deadline.
- 3. If the homecoming court applicants exceed 24, candidates will be selected based on the highest GPA and/or class rank. Campaigning will be allowed for ONLY THE TOP 6 King and Queen Candidates; THE TOP 2 Prince and Princess Candidates; and THE TOP 2 Duke and Duchess Candidates. Since Freshman will not have a GPA, they will be selected based on their current grades at the time of their application and teacher recommendations. All materials must be approved by the SGA Council Advisors before being posted on the walls.
 - > YOU ARE LIMITED TO THREE POSTERS.
 - > ALL CAMPAIGNING MUST BE POSITIVE!
 - > NO CAMPAIGNING ALLOWED UNTIL GIVEN AUTHORITY TO BY THE SGA ADVISORS
 - i. Campaigning of any kind without consent will result in automatic dismissal from the process.
 - > NO FOOD, CANDY, OR MONETARY GIFTS FOR VOTES
- 4. Seniors on Homecoming Court (Top 6) must submit a ½ page **biography** including name/relationship of escort, school activities, community activities, and plan for future education and career by the designated deadline. Biographies will be shortened as necessary.
- 5. King/Queen Candidate Discipline Guidelines: **No disciplinary alternative education program** for candidates' 4 years of high school. No ISS or OSS for candidates' senior year. Candidates' discipline and attendance will be reviewed by school Administration to determine eligibility for participation.
- 6. King/Queen Candidates who accumulate more than three absences as of the first day of school in any class will be removed from the ballot; for example if a candidate misses 2 "A" day classes and 2 "B" day classes they would still be eligible. No more than 16 Total Tardies.
- 7. King/Queen Candidates must be in compliance with all student code of conduct rules.
- 8. Any King/Queen Candidate who uses or possesses, with viable proof (i.e. witnesses, pictures and recording) illegal drugs, alcohol, or tobacco on or off school property will be dismissed from participation in Homecoming Court elections and activities.

Homecoming Parade, Pep Rally, and Game Dress Guidelines

King/Queen Candidates who are **dressed inappropriately** for the homecoming parade, pep rally, and game **will not be allowed to participate**. Please allow SGA Advisors and administrator to view your attire for all activities no later than 3:00pm on Wednesday of Homecoming week Candidates must follow all rules as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct unless otherwise stated in these guidelines.
